# UP woman cop attack: 'Prime suspect' killed in encounter

IN A PURPORTED encounter in the Inayat Nagar area of Ayodhya district, the Uttar Pradesh Police's Special Task Force (STF) on Thursday night killed a 28-year-old man who they claimed was the prime suspect in a brutal attack on a policewoman aboard the Saryu Express train on August 29 and arrested his two associates after they were injured.

The woman head constable (40), who was found unconscious in a compartment of the train at the Ayodhya junction the next morning with injuries on her face, was travelling to join duty in Ayodhya.

The deceased has been identified as Anis Khan (28), a resident of Haiderganj in Ayodhya

district, while those arrested are Vishambhar Dayal Dubey (45) of Sultanpur and Azad (30) of Haiderganj.

Both Azad and Vishambhar are being treated at a hospital for bullet injuries.

The police said the three suspects have had a criminal past with charges of attempt to murder, robbery, and theft against them. They also face cases under the Cow Slaughter Act, Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and the UP Gangster Act, it is learnt.

While Anis faced six cases, Azad has 12 and Vishambhar three, they added.

Special Director General of Police (Law and Order) Prashant Kumar said the three attacked and injured the constable after finding her alone in the compartment while trying to snatch her bag.

A senior STF official said, "During questioning, Azad said they shifted to another compartment at the Mankapur railway station and found the woman sleeping on a bench. They tried to snatch her bag but she woke up and slapped one of them. On this, they got infuriated and attacked her with blades they were carrying. They also smashed her head against a window of the train several times, rendering her unconscious."

A joint team of the STF and the local police traced the assailants with the help of technical and human surveillance, he added. The probe team collected some photographs of the alleged assailants and showed it to the victim who identified them.

Ayodhya Superintendent of Police (SP) Raj Karan Nayyar said the accused opened fire when a

team went to arrest them in the Inayat Nagar area.

"The police fired in retaliation, leaving Azad and Dubey injured, while Anish managed to escape. After a brief chase, the police traced him to the Pura Kalandar locality where he fired at them. But he was killed in the retaliatory firing," the SP said.

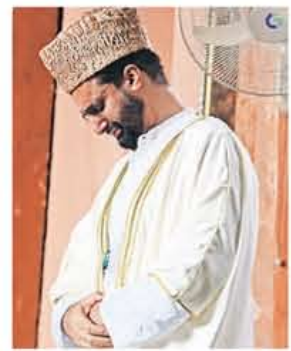
A policeman also suffered a minor bullet injury in the cross-firing, he added.

The FIR in the case was registered under Sections 307 (attempt to murder) and 332 (voluntarily causing hurt to a public servant) of the Indian Penal Code. The police have added Sections 354-B (assault or use of criminal force to woman with intent to disrobe) and 394 (voluntarily causing hurt in committing robbery) against the accused.

# Out after four years, Mirwaiz backs PM on 'not an era of war', seeks Pandit return

DRESSED IN his white and gold ceremonial robes, Mirwaiz Umar Farooq returned to Srinagar's Jamia Masjid for the first time since August 2019, having spent more than four years in detention at home. Breaking down as he climbed the pulpit of the mosque to begin his sermon, the Hurriyat chairman said he would continue to seek "a peaceful resolution" of people's issues, despite paying the price for it.

Referring to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's words against the backdrop of the Russia-Ukraine war, the Mirwaiz added that he agreed with the PM that this was not an era of war.

Umar Farooq was received by an emotional crowd of hundreds as he returned to lead prayers after 212 weeks, at Jamia Masjid, Nowhatta, with chants of "Marhaba, Mirwaiz". People had started trooping in as news of the Mirwaiz's release from detention spread, with scores of security officials keeping a watch.

"We have been called sepa-

ratist, anti-national and peace disruptors. However, we have no personal benefits to gain from this, I did not have any personal ambition here. We only represent the interests and aspirations of the people of Jammu and Kashmir. We seek a peaceful resolution of the issues, but on their (the people's) terms," he said.

The Mirwaiz also called for the return of "our Pandit brothers" to Kashmir. "We have always advocated the return of Kashmiri Pandits and disapproved of making this human issue a political one."

# Andhra Pradesh skill development corp scam: Two-day CID custody for Naidu

DISMISSING HIS plea seeking quashing of the FIR, the Andhra Pradesh High Court on Friday sent former chief minister N Chandrababu Naidu to two-day CID custody for interrogation in the Skill Development Corporation scam.

Rejecting the argument that Naidu's arrest was invalid under Section 17A of the Prevention of Corruption Act — it mandates seeking approval for inquiry into any offence committed by a public servant — the court observed that the case was in final stages and it was not inclined to interfere with it. Seeking the TDP chief's custody, the CID had told the court that investigation was important in the criminal case and that quashing the arrest was possible only after completion of the probe.

Naidu was arrested by the state CID from Nandalay early morning on September 9 in connection with the multi-crore AP State Skill Development Corporation scam allegedly during his tenure as CM from 2014 to 2019. An Anti Corruption Bureau (ACB) court in Vijayawada had sent Naidu to 14-day judicial custody on September 10.

He was then shifted to Rajahmundry Central Jail, 200 km from Vijayawada. On Friday, the ACB court extended his judicial custody till September 24.

Apart from the Skill Development case, the state CID is also seeking to interrogate Naidu over alleged irregularities during his tenure in the construction of the inner ring road in capital Amaravati, besides an alleged scam in the AP Fibernet Limited.

Besides Naidu, those named in the Amaravati road FIR are: former Minister for Municipal Administration and Urban Development Ponuguru Narayana; businessman Lingamaneni Ramesh and Lingamaneni Venkata Surya Rajasekar of Lingamaneni group of companies; K P V Anjani Kumar of R K Housing Ltd; N Lokesh Naidu; and M/s Heritage Foods Pvt Ltd.

# J&K police set up cell to promote, implement Hindi in Jammu division

Jammu: The Jammu and Kashmir Police, in a bid to promote and implement Hindi language in its offices across Jammu division of the Union Territory, have constituted a 20-member promotion cell.

The Hindi promotion cell, as per an order dated September 21 issued by Additional Director General of Police, Jammu zone, Mukesh Singh, will have a staff officer to ADGP, Jammu zone, function as a nodal officer to ensure compliance of the circular, earlier issued by police headquarters.

Prior to August 5, 2019, abrogation of Article 370, Jammu and Kashmir had all its official work done in Urdu and English, being its official languages. ENS

# Report on recovery of arms filed: Manipur to SC

THE MANIPUR government has filed a report sought by the Supreme Court on the status of recovery of arms from "all sources" in the violence-hit state, it told the

top court Friday. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for Manipur, conveyed this to a three-judge bench presided by Chief Justice of India D.Y.Chandrachud which said it will peruse the report. In its August 7 order appointing former Mumbai police com-

missioner Dattatray Padsalgikar to "overall monitor" the probe being carried out by the CBI into the instances of sexual violence in Manipur, the Supreme Court had also directed the state to "take stock of the number of arms missing or looted from the armouries of the state and of these, the num-

ber of arms which have been recovered. Formulate and implement a plan to recover any missing arms". Taking note of Mehta's submission, the bench, also comprising Justices J B Pardiwala and Manoj Misra, Friday said it will look into the report.
