Maha Metro's Nagpur-Kamptee Road Double Decker Gets Build India Infra Award 2025

Nagpur 26 February: The Kamptee Road Double Decker Viaduct constructed by Maha Metro, Nagpur has bagged the prestigious Build India Infra Award 2025 in the Sustainability Category - Urban Transport. The award was conferred upon Maha Metro during the Build India Infra Awards 2025 presentation ceremony held on 24th February, 2025, in New Delhi. Build India - a prominent organization working in field of Infrastructure & Urban Transportation, described it as "Double Decker Viaduct at Nagpur Metro" project. It may be recalled that the Double Decker was inaugurated by Hon Union Minister Shri Nitin Gadkari and other dignitaries on 5th October 2024. The Double Decker Viaduct over Kamptee Road is a groundbreaking Multilayer Transportation System that seamlessly integrates Metro Rail at the top, a Highway Flyover at the middle level, and the existing road at the ground level. A railway track connecting Nagpur and Delhi is another level, as part of the 4-layer structure. Constructed at a cost of ₹ 573 crore and amidst heavy vehicular traffic, this double decker viaduct is 5.637 km long, making it the longest Double Decker Viaduct on any Metro Rail system. This project demonstrates an innovative approach to resource management, eco-friendly infrastructure, and long-term environmental responsibility. Designed with a common superstructure and independent substructures for the Highway Flyover and Metro Rail, the double decker viaduct results in substantial savings in time and cost by avoiding additional land acquisition and enabling faster construction. This award has reinvigorated Maha Metro's commitment to building user-friendly, sustainable and innovative public transport structures and systems. With this milestone, Maha Metro continues to lead the way in transforming urban transportation and infrastructure in Nagpur.

'Revenue department, administration meted out injustice to victims for 13 years'

Duo deprived of government jobs due to false allegations

Chandrapur 26 February: Despite the civil court having the right to summon registered documents, the opposite party filed an appeal against the prize certificate document in the Warora Sub-Divisional Officer's Court. In the year 2016, the SDO of Warora has done injustice to the family by depriving both the children of Vaishali Bothale of their jobs in WCL for 13 years by issuing a fake order. In this concern, the victim Bothale family and Vinod Khobragade, due to the anguish caused, have demanded a compensation of Rs 1 crore each from the district administration and have demanded in a press conference to register an FIR against the guilty Patwari, Divisional Officer, Tehsildar and Sub-Divisional Officer who have caused them hardship. If the demand is not fulfilled within a span of 7 days, a complaint has been warned against the senior officials before the judge. Vinod Khobragade said in a

suffered huge financial loss for as many as 13 years. After filing an appeal against the fake order of the SDO with the Chandrapur Additional District Magistrate, in 2022, the SDO's order was nullified and the names of Satbara holders Sunny Bothale and Sanjay Bothale were revised as per the original records. But even after three years, the Talathi, Divisional Officer, Tehsildar, Warora sub-divisional officer are violating the order of the District Magistrate and doing injustice to the family. In this concern, the Bothale family's problem was that Vinod Khobragade filed a complaint to amend the records as per the order and on 18 February 2025, the Marda Talathi and the circle Officer were forced to prepare a Satbara document in the name of the original owners Sunny and Sanjay and the Satbara document was in the name of the original owner. They have demanded that Sunny and Sanjay be given a compensation of Rs 1 crore each for the loss caused to the Bothale family due to the injustice meted out to them by the revenue department and administration for the last 13 years and that an FIR be registered against the Talathi, Divisional Officer, Warora Tehsildar, Sub-Divisional Officer for making fake changes in the land records. If the demand is not fulfilled within 7 days, a complaint will be filed before the judge. Vaishali Bothale, Baliram Bothale and Vinod Khobragade were present during the press conference.

CBSE class X board examinations twice a year from 2026

Nagpur/New Delhi 26 February: Students taking the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) Class X Board exams will be able to select between two exam sessions beginning in 2026: One in February 2026 and another in May 2026. Additionally, candidates will have the choice to take both tests if they so choose. Furthermore, if students are already happy with their results from the first exam and the particular course or subjects they took in the first attempt, they will be permitted to avoid it in the second attempt. The CBSE authorized the draft of guidelines for the implementation of the twice-yearly board exam system on Tuesday. Stakeholders have until March 9 to offer comments and ideas on these proposed standards, which are now up for public review. The final policy will be decided upon and formally put into effect based on the inputs submitted. As per the media reports, the first phase of the Class X Board exams will be held from February 17 to March 6, 2026, and the second phase will be held from May 5 to May 20, 2026. Both tests will adhere to the current comprehensive curriculum and required readings. Students will have the same examination centres for both editions.

the recently suggested norms. This indicates that the list for the exam in February 2026 will be finalized by September 2025. If a candidate was not on the September 2025 list, they will not be permitted to register for the May 2026 exam. Additionally, CBSE has declared that candidates would not be allowed to switch subjects once the LOC is finalized. However, the choice of subjects is somewhat flexible. A candidate can change their subject selections by choosing a different subject for the second exam (May) and skipping a subject in the first exam (February-March). If a candidate decides to retake the exam after finishing all the subjects in the first one, they will have to take the same courses again.

No separate supplementary exams. The Board has made it clear that this system will not be used for separate supplemental exams. Rather, for individuals who want to raise their results, a reduction in the "high-stakes" aspect of board exams. To make this possible, students can now take board exams twice in one academic year.
