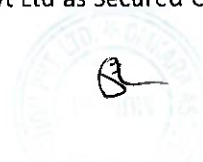

New Lease of Life for Rural Water Bodies with Pond Modernisation

TSIT, Visakhapatnam
The State Government is taking up extensive modernisation of water bodies across Andhra Pradesh to meet the objectives of conserving irrigation resources, improving groundwater levels, protecting the environment and providing better recreational facilities for rural communities. The initiative has gained momentum through the efforts of Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kildan and support under the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY). A total of 150 ponds are being modernised across the

State at an estimated cost of around Rs.50 crore. So far, works on 26 ponds have been completed and the renovated water bodies have been made available to the public. The works have been completed in several districts, including Anantapur, Palnadu, Sri Sathya, Sri Chittoor, Kurnool, Sri Potti Sreemulu Nellore, Kakinada and Guntur, while works on the remaining ponds are progressing at various stages.

As part of the modernisation pond bunds are being strengthened and facilities such as walking tracks, entrance gates,



solar lighting, seating benches, children's parks and open-air gyms are being developed. The objective is to transform

water resources. Among the ponds already developed are Vedula Cheruvu in Kuppam constituency of Chittoor district, Panduru Cheruvu in Kakinada Rural constituency, Vengalavapalem Cheruvu in Guntur district, Gudiseppalli Cheruvu in Anantapur district, Vinjamuri Cheruvu in Nellore district and Palasamudram Cheruvu in Sri Sathyasaipur district.

With changing consumer preferences and growing demand for handicraft products the Central and State Governments are taking steps to strengthen the livelihoods and financial security of artisans. Andhra Pradesh Training programmes are being launched to enhance the skills of handicraft artisans and enable them to revive traditional art forms with contemporary designs. Handlooms and Textiles Minister S. Savitri said the central Government has sanctioned Rs 1,57,16,914 for the training programmes, which will benefit around 770 handicraft artisans across the State. Depending on the craft,

the leadership of Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu, has already been implementing several initiatives to strengthen the handloom sector and

increase the sales of handloom products. Such measures are now being extended to handicrafts to improve their skills, income and employment opportunities with the support of the Central Government. As part of the programme, artisans engaged in various traditional crafts will receive training through Guna-Shiksha - Host Shipments, Skill Development and Design (GSDP) and Weavexys (DWX) (CH). Wijaya swears the illegal smuggling and trading of subsidized ration rice are rampant in the West constituency with a notorious kumpun turning into a powerful syndicate. Kott, who previously dominated the central constituency, has reportedly found his regional operation in the West establishing himself as the undisputed Ration Don of the area. Allegations are flying that Kott's network of fair price shops (ration stores) in the constituency have been forcibly brought under his control. Targeted Ration Sources reveal a chilling modus operandi: ration dealers are given a flat 10-million rupiah (about \$1,000) subsidized rice to Kott's satisfaction. Those who comply are left unharmed, while those who resist face the wrath of state machinery. It is alleged that certain corrupt officials within the central constituency's Vigilance Department fured by hefty bribes are actively backing Kott. These officials are reportedly orchestrating targeted raids threatening to cancel the licenses of dealers who refuse to cooperate with the syndicate.

"The Price Bandwidth," Smuggling EconomicsKott, notorious for his ability to control the West's trade systems, has set up a highly profitable network that loots essential commodities meant for the local population. The illegal supply chain of this illegal trade operates as follows: Procurement from Cardholders Rice is bought from cardholders at Rp12 per kg. Dealer's Cut The ration dealer receives an additional margin of Rp32 per kg. from the government. The middleman facilitating the deal pockets another Rp2 per kg. The Don's Little Share The 10-million rupiah built stock is then diverted to the black market, letting massive, multi crore profit margins for Kott. Bribes Completed Kott's schemes in the central constituency. Kott's aggressive expansion into the West has left local ration dealers in a bind. Dealers are growing weaker from both looting and honest dealers for a high-level independent inquirer into the matter. But the rampant illicit trade and the complicit vigilance officers enable it.
