Centre forms committee to tackle 'misleading' ads on processed food

Panel to develop strategy on food labeling HARIKISHAN SHARMA NEW DELHI, FEBRUARY 7

THE CENTRE has formed a 19-member committee, headed by Union Minister of Food Processing Industries Chirag Paswan, to counter misleading publicity for processed food. Drawing its members from other ministries, including Health and Consumer Affairs, and industry representatives, the panel will assume the role of a "policy-making body giving overall directions and guidance".

The Ministry of Food Processing and Industries has notified the constitution of the committee and its terms of reference. The committee will soon hold its first meeting, said a source.

According to the terms of reference, the committee would develop and implement a comprehensive strategy to identify, prevent and address misleading publicity of processed foods, ensuring accurate information for consumers and fostering ethical advertising practices in the processed food industry.

Food Processors' Association; Federation of Sweets & Namkeen Manufacturers; Indian Beverage Association, and Plant Based Food Industry Association. The food processing sector has emerged as a significant driver of growth in recent years, recording an average annual growth rate of around 5.35 per cent in 8 years through 2022-23. During this period, the food processing sector's growth rate has been higher compared to the agriculture and allied sectors.

The food processing sector contributed 7.66% and 8.45% of Gross Value Addition in the manufacturing and agriculture sectors respectively during 2022-23, according to the Ministry of Food Processing Industries. The sector also plays a significant role in providing job opportunities. "According to the latest Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) for 2021-22, the total number of persons engaged in the registered food processing sector was 20.68 lakhs. The unregistered food processing sector supported employment to 51.11 lakh workers as per the NSSO 73rd Round, 2015-16 and constituted 14.18% of employment in the unregistered manufacturing sector," states the annual report of the Food Processing Industries Ministry for the financial year 2023-24.

HC refuses to quash POCSO case against ex-CM Yediyurappa

THE KARNATAKA High Court Friday quashed a special court's order taking cognizance of the case against former Karnataka chief minister B S Yediyurappa, 81, under the POCSO Act, but allowed the criminal proceedings against him to continue.

In his plea, Yediyurappa, who was accused of sexually inappropriate behaviour by the mother of a teenager in March last year, had sought the quashing of the case as well cognizance taken of the case by the special court on July 6 last year. Yediyurappa had been summoned to appear in the special court before the framing of charges.

"The writ petition is allowed in part. The order of taking cognizance by the concerned court dated July 6, 2024 qua accused number one stands obliterated. The crime, the investigation and

the final report all remain intact. The matter is remitted back to the concerned court to pass appropriate orders on the final report so placed before it by the CID bearing in mind the observations made in the course of the order," Justice M Nagaprasanna Friday.

"It is made clear that this court has not answered any of the contentions advanced by both the senior counsels for the petitioner and respondent except with respect to taking cognizance. All other contentions would remain open. The petitioner is at liberty to avail of remedy as is available under law at the appropriate stage before the appropriate forums," the HC said in the summary of the order.

The development means that the special court will have to reconsider the chargesheet before deciding to summon Yediyurappa to start the trial process in the POCSO case.

JUSTICE HEMA COMMITTEE REPORT: SC REFUSES TO INTERVENE IN ORDER DIRECTING POLICE TO FILE CASES

New Delhi: The Supreme Court Friday refused to intervene with the Kerala HC order directing the police to register cases on complaints of sexual exploitation in Malayalam cinema, raised before Justice Hema Committee.

A three-judge bench, presided by Justice Vikram Nath, said that "under criminal jurisprudence, once information is received or otherwise and the officer in charge of the police sta-

tion has reason to suspect that a cognizable offence has been committed, he is duty bound to proceed in accordance with the law as prescribed under Section 176 BNSs."

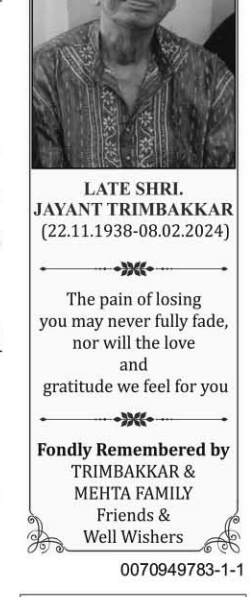
