UDAIPUR: Irrigation Minister N. Uttam Kumar Reddy secured an assurance from Union Minister for Jal Shakti CR Patil, that the Centre would intervene in addressing Telangana's water concerns and expedite approvals for key irrigation projects. During a meeting on the

sidelines of the 2nd All India State Water Ministers' Conference on Wednesday, Uttam Kumar Reddy also held discussions with Debasish Mukherjee, Secretary, Ministry of Jal Sakhti, pressing for immediate action on water disputes and funding for critical projects.

Uttam Kumar Reddy raised concerns over Andhra Pradesh allegedly drawing excess water illegally from the backwaters of the Srisailam Dam and the right canal of the Nagarjuna Sagar Project during the ongoing Rabi season. He emphasised the urgent need for Central intervention to protect the Rabi crop in the ayacut areas of Nagarjuna Sagar, particularly in the erstwhile



Nalgonda and Khammam districts. In response, Union Minister Patil assured that the Centre would take immediate steps to ensure fair water distribution and prevent unauthorised withdrawals.

To enhance transparency and prevent future disputes, Uttam Kumar Reddy advocated for the installation of telemetry systems at both Srisailam and Nagarjuna Sagar dams, at a total of 35 points on Krishna river water, including above. These systems would provide real-time data on water usage, ensur-

ing adherence to allocated quotas. The Union Minister concurred, recognising the importance of accurate monitoring mechanisms.

Stressing the need for

accelerated approvals and funding, Uttam Kumar Reddy urged the Centre to sanction key irrigation projects, including the Palamuru-Rangareddy Lift Irrigation Scheme (PRLIS), Sitarama Sagar Project, and Sammakka Sagar Project. He also demanded that PRLIS be granted national project status and receive full Central funding. Secretary Mukherjee assured

that the Centre would explore the possibility of providing infrastructure funds for Telangana's irrigation projects at zero per cent interest with a 50-year repayment period. She also committed to granting all necessary approvals for the Sitarama Sagar Project within a month.

Uttam Kumar Reddy requested Central assistance for the cleaning and rejuvenation of the Musi River and the development of the Godavari-Musi link. The Union Minister acknowledged the significance of these projects and agreed

to consider the proposals of the Telangana government. He also raised concerns about the prolonged inquiry by the National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA) into the collapse of the Medigadda Project, which has been ongoing for a year. He urged for the early submission of the report and recommendations for remedial actions. Union Minister Patil assured that the NDSA's findings would be made available by the end of the month. The Centre also suggested that Telangana utilise the World Bank-assisted Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (DRIP) funds for repairs at Nagarjuna Sagar and Srisailam dams, as well as for desiltation and sedimentation management across irrigation projects.

Uttam Kumar Reddy emphasised the need for the Centre's intervention to expedite the proceedings of the Krishna Water Disputes Tribunal-II (KWDT-II). An early judgment is crucial to ensure Telangana receives its rightful water share.

Bjp-Brs working together to defeat Cong in MLC elections: TPCC chief

KAMAREDDY: Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC) president Mahesh Kumar Goud has alleged that there is a secret agreement between the BJP and BRS regarding the MLC elections, indicating that the opposition party is backing the BJP candidate to secure a victory in the polls.

During a meeting with graduates in Kamareddy on Wednesday, the TPCC chief remarked that it has become customary for the BJP to invoke divine support to attract votes during elections. He also pointed out that both BJP and BRS are exploiting social media to disseminate misinformation.

He urged the graduates to counter the BJP-BRS alliance and ensure a significant victory for the Congress candidate, Narender Reddy, in the MLC elections.

Moreover, the TPCC

chief highlighted that while the previous BRS created government 50,000 jobs over a decade, the current Congress administration has managed to provide more than 55,000 jobs in just one year. The State government has carried out a caste census survey in accordance with the request of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, fulfilling its commitment to the backward classes (BCs). Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's administration is diligently working to support these communities, Mahesh Goud said. He emphasized that true social justice for the BCs can only be achieved through the Congress

MP Chamala Kiran Kumar Reddy has dismissed the comments made by BRS President and former Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao, who suggested that byelections in Telangana would occur in the near future.

In a statement released on Wednesday, the Congress MP expressed his belief that by-elections are unlikely to take place over the next five years, labeling KCR's assertions as unrealistic.

"KCR's party lacks a significant presence even in local body elections. This is the reason behind his attempts to motivate the party's cadre with such statements. If KCR were truly courageous, he would participate in the Assembly as the opposition leader to address the people's issues, but he shows no genuine commitment to addressing these concerns," Kiran Kumar Reddy stated.

Cong urges Left parties to back its MLC candidate

THE Congress party on Wednesday sent letters to different political parties seeking their support for MLC candidate V Narender Reddy. PCC president B Mahesh Kumar Goud urged CPI, CPM and TJS to back the candidature of Congress candidate in the upcoming Karimnagar - Nizamabad - Adilabad -Medak Graduates constitu-

ency. Urging the leaders to stay united and ensure the defeat of communal party like BJP in MLC polls, the PCC chief sent letters to CPI state secretary and MLA Kunamneni Sambhashiva Rao, TJS president and MLC, Prof Kodandaram, CPM state secretary John

Wesley on Wednesday. He stated that the defeat of BJP would also ensure crushing the BRS party, which ruled in an autocratic manner during its tenure. While pointing out that the present Congress government was functioning as per the aspirations of general public and socialist ethos, he urged the leaders to ensure their entire cadre backs Congress candidates.

The party leadership is taking these polls with much prestige, as the MLC polls are the first elections being held after Mahesh Kumar Goud took charge as PCC president. HYDERABAD: Minister for Revenue and Housing Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy has commented that former chief minister and BRS President K Chandrashekar Rao is a politician who only makes his presence felt during election

He pointed out that KTR has spent the past 14 months at his farmhouse while attempting to persuade the public of the upcoming local elections. According to Ponguleti, it would be wiser for KCR to focus on his own future and that of his party rather than concerning himself with the future of the Congress party.
