Elevated as a judge of the Supreme Court on January 18, 2019, Justice Khanna will superanuate on May 13, 2025, making it a tenure of little over six months. He is among the few

advocate with the Bar Council of Delhi in 1983 and initially prac-ticed at the district courts at Tis Hazari complex and later moved to the High Court of Delhi and Justice Khanna had a long

tenure as the Senior Standing Counsel for the Income Tax Department and in 2004 he was appointed Standing Counsel
