



Spanish prosecutors accuse Rubiales of sexual assault

BARCELONA: Spanish state prosecutors have filed a lawsuit against Luis Rubiales for sexual assault and coercion for kissing a player on the lips without her consent after the Women's World Cup final, the country's prosecutors' office said Friday. Rubiales, the now-suspended president of the Spanish soccer federation, kissed Jenni Hermoso on the lips during the awards ceremony after Spain beat England to win the title on Aug. 20 in Sydney, Australia. Prosecutors presented the suit to Spain's National Court in Madrid two days after Hermoso formally accused Rubiales of sexual assault.

CHINA SECURES WOMEN'S SINGLES TITLE

Manush Shah/Manav Thakkar lose in quarters

PYEONGCHANG (SOUTH KOREA)

India's Manush Shah and Manav Thakkar lost in the men's doubles quarterfinals as China dominated the 2023 Asian Table Tennis Championships on Friday. In the women's doubles quarterfinals, the Indian pair of Ayhika Mukherjee and Sutirtha Mukherjee of India lost to Chinese players, Wang Manyu and Chen Meng with set scores of 11-5, 13-11, 12-10.

The young Indian pair of Manav and Manush went down to Fan Zhendong and Lin Gaoyuan of China in their quarter-final match,

going down 3-0 in straight games. The Indian pair, who had reached the last-eight stage by beating the Uzbek combine of Abdulaziz Anorbov and Kutbidillo Teshaboev, went down 5-11, 3-11, 5-11 in the quarterfinal clash in

Pyeongchang Dome.

In the other men's doubles quarterfinal, the duo of Ma Long and Wang Chuqin overcame Wong Chun Ting and Ho Kwan Kit of Hong Kong, China with set scores of 8-11, 11-8, 11-3. Saturday's semifinals will feature two Chinese pairs

and Wang Yidi triumphed over Miura Hirano and Miwa Harimoto of Japan, scoring 11-5, 12-10, 11-5. China dominated the women's singles section with Sun Yingsha, Chen Xingtong, Wang Yidi, and Wang Manyu all advancing to the semifinals, reports Xinhua.

US OPEN 2023

Gauff holds off Muchova; Sabalenka outlasts Keys to reach final

NEW YORK

For the second time in her career, American teen sensation Coco Gauff will play in a Grand Slam final after a straight-sets win against Karolina Muchova at the US Open.

The sixth-seeded Gauff has won 11 straight matches, the best streak of her career, and 17 of 18, a stretch that includes titles in Washington D.C. and Cincinnati. Gauff is the youngest of the four semifinalists here — by nearly six years. The 19-year-old, is also the youngest American women's player to appear in the final of the US Open since Serena Williams in 1999. She's looking to become the fourth American woman to win the Open this century after Serena, her sister Venus and Sloane

Nagal shocks top seed Ramos-Vinolas to enter semifinals

TULLN (AUSTRIA)

India's Sumit Nagal pulled off a stunning straight set win over top seed Spaniard Albert Ramos-Vinolas to enter the men's singles semifinals at



Austrian Challenger event here on Friday.

Playing for the third time in their career, Nagal registered a 7-6, 6-3 win over world number 88 Ramos-Vinolas on centre court. The 26-year-old from Jhajjar will face the winner of the match between German H Squire and fourth seed Italian F Cobolli. The duo came into the tournament with a 1-1 head-to-head count with Nagal losing to Ramos-Vinolas in the quarterfinals in Buenos Aires back in 2021.

'Serena is the GOAT, can't compare myself to her'

American tennis sensation Coco Gauff holds back on comparison with the American legend of the game and says 'Serena is Serena', She's the GOAT. Talking to ESPN Gauff stated, that Serena is the greatest of all time and, the only regret she'll have in her life, is not playing against Serena Williams. "I don't think I'm carrying American tennis. I don't think I will. We have so many compatriots who are doing well. Serena is Serena. She's the GOAT. I'd hope to do half of what she did. But I'm not gonna compare myself to her. She's someone I look up to. Being in the same stat line as her means a lot to me. She's my idol. The only regret I'll have for the rest of my life is not being able to play her. there were so many tournaments where if we won an extra round & didn't lose, I would've played her. I'm still happy to just be a product of her

Stephens.

Moreover, Gauff is the youngest woman to appear in multiple Grand Slam finals (including 2020 Roland Garros) since Maria Sharapova (2004 Wimbledon and 2006 US Open) and the youngest American woman to do it since Monica Seles, from 1990-93. In the Saturday's final, Gauff will meet No.2 Aryna Sabalenka, who narrowly escaped No.17 Madison Keys in a third-set tiebreak in the second

Sabalenka continues a breakthrough season at the majors with her second Slam final this year. She is also the first player to reach the semifinals of all four Grand Slam events in a single year since Serena did so in 2016. The post-midnight victory marks Sabalenka's 50th match-win of the year. It is the first time in her career that Sabalenka has hit that total number of four-level wins in a single season.

Bopanna-Ebden lose in final

NEW YORK : Rohan Bopanna, Matthew Ebden crashed to a defeat in the US Open 2023 men's doubles final against Rajeev Ram and Joe Salisbury, at the Flushing Meadows in New York. The Indian-Aussie pair won the first set 6-2 after some brilliant tennis. But Ram-Salisbury staged a comeback and won the second set 6-3. Then in the decider, which was nervy towards the end, Ram and Salisbury ended sealing a 2-6 6-3 6-4 victory to clinch the Grand Slam title.

Achinta Sheuli finishes 8th in men's 73kg Group D

RIYADH: Commonwealth Games gold medalist weightlifter Achinta Sheuli was far from his best as he finished a disappointing eighth in Group D of the men's 73kg event at the World Championships here on Friday. Sheuli had three failed attempts - two in snatch section and one in clean and jerk as he managed a total effort of 285kg (130kg+155kg). The 21-year-old junior World Championships silver medalist has a personal best of 313kg in total, 143kg in snatch and 173kg in clean and jerk. The other Indian lifter in the fray in the men's 73kg event, Narayana Ajith will be in action on Saturday as he has been assigned Group C.
