US, Brazil leaders to meet amid tensions

Trump says he and Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva have agreed to meet next week as tensions between their countries have spiked in recent months under heavy Trump administration criticism. He said him and Lula spoke briefly as they passed each other. "I saw him, he saw me and we embraced," Trump said after criticising Brazil for its tariffs and prosecution of former Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro.

Public invited to walk streets, join dinner in DC

Trump shifted to talking about crime overall and specifically his crackdown in the US capital, asserting that the city is "a totally safe city" after he flooded the streets with National Guard troops and federal law enforcement officers. "I welcome you to come," Trump said. "In fact, we'll have dinner together at a local restaurant and we'll be able to walk. We don't have to go by an armored plated vehicle."

Time to choose between peace and war: UN chief

With global peace and progress under siege, the United Nations chief challenged world leaders on Tuesday to choose a future where the rule of law triumphs over raw power and where nations come together rather than scramble for self-interests. Secretary-General Antonio Guterres told world leaders that today's choice between peace or war, law or lawlessness, and cooperation or conflict is "more urgent and unforgiving."

PRESIDENT Donald Trump returned to the United Nations on Tuesday to boast of his second-term foreign policy achievements and lash out at the world body as a feckless institution, while warning Europe it would be ruined if it doesn't turn away from a "double-tailed monster" of ill-conceived migration and green energy policies.

World leaders listened closely to his remarks at the UN General Assembly as Trump has already moved quickly to diminish US support for the world body in his first eight months in office. Even in his first term, he was no fan of the flavor of multilateralism that the United Nations espouses.

After his latest inauguration, he issued a first-day executive order withdrawing the US from the World Health Organization. That was followed by his move to end

US participation in the UN Human Rights Council, and ordering up a review of US membership in hundreds of intergovernmental organisations aimed at determining whether they align with the priorities of his "America First" agenda.

Trump escalated that criticism on Tuesday, saying it's "empty words don't solve wars." "What is the purpose of the United Nations?" Trump said. "The UN has such tremendous potential. I've always said it. It has such tremendous, tremendous potential. But it's not even coming close to living up to that potential."

Trump offered a weave of jarring juxtapositions in his address to the assembly.

He trumpeted himself as a peacemaker and enumerated successes of his administration's efforts in several hotspots around the globe. At the same, Trump heralded his decisions to order the US

military to carry out strikes on Iran and more recently against alleged drug smugglers from Venezuela and argued that globalists are on the verge of destroying successful nations.

Trump touted his administration's policies allowing for expanded drilling for oil and natural gas in the United States, and aggressively cracking down on illegal immigration, implicitly suggesting more countries should follow suit.

He sharply warned that European nations that have more welcoming migration policies and commit to expensive energy projects aimed at reducing their carbon footprint were causing irreparable harm to their economies and cultures.

"I'm telling you that if you don't get away from the 'green energy' scam, your country is going to fail," Trump said.

"If you don't stop people that you've never seen before that you have nothing in common with your country is going to fail." Trump added, "I love the people of Europe, and I hate to see it being devastated by energy and immigration. This double-tailed monster destroys everything in its wake, and they cannot let that happen any longer."

The passage of the wide-ranging address elicited some groans and uncomfortable laughter from delegates.

Trump urged European countries to abandon green energy initiatives, scoffing that, in decades past, some experts predicted that by the year 2000 "climate change will cause a global catastrophe." He said scientists predicted some nations might be "wiped off the map" by now, but insisted that's "not happening." AP

Russian strikes kill civilians, Ukrainian drones shot down

KYIV

Russia said that it shot down three dozen Ukrainian drones heading toward Moscow while Ukraine said that Russian missiles, drones and bombs killed at least two civilians, as Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy persevered with efforts to bolster international support for his country at a UN gathering of world leaders on Tuesday.

With his troops under strain on the front line after more than three years of fighting Russia's bigger invading army, Zelenskyy was due to begin meetings with leaders gathered in New York this week for the UN General Assembly. They included US President Donald Trump, Zelenskyy's spokesperson,

RUSSIA SUSPECTED IN DRONE SHUTDOWN

COPENHAGEN: Several unidentified drones shut down airspace over Copenhagen Airport on Monday night, prompting concerns that Russia could be behind the flyover above Scandinavia's largest airport. There was no indication that the operators of two to three drones intended to cause harm to anyone, police said, and the drones disappeared after hours. While it wasn't clear who was behind the flyover, Denmark's prime minister and NATO's secretary-general said that Russian involvement couldn't be ruled out.

Serhii Nykyforov, told The Associated Press. Peace efforts set in motion by Trump since he returned to office in January appear to have stalled. Trump's Alaska summit with Russian President Vladimir Putin and a White House meeting with Zelenskyy and key European leaders took place more than a month ago, but the war has continued unabated.

Zelenskyy said that he met late Monday in New

York with Keith Kellogg, Trump's special envoy. Kellogg and Zelenskyy discussed cooperation agreements on the manufacturing of drones and Ukraine's purchase of American weaponry, the Ukrainian president said on Telegram. European leaders have supported Zelenskyy's diplomatic efforts, even as the Israel-Hamas war in Gaza is expected to take center stage at the United Nations. AP

3.7L EVACUATED

China’s global industrial hub closes ahead of typhoon

BEIJING

CHINA's global manufacturing hub, Guangdong province, on Tuesday evacuated over 3.71 lakh people while its modern and affluent cities like Shenzhen shut down to face Super Typhoon Ragasa, stated to be the most powerful storm to hit the region in recent years.

The province raised its emergency response to the highest level on Tuesday as Ragasa is forecast to make landfall along the central or western coastal areas of the province.

More than 10 cities, including the technology hub Shenzhen, have announced the closure of all markets, schools, factories and transport systems, advising people to stay indoors and stockpile food and water, the Hong Kong-based South China Morning Post reported.

More than 371,000 people have been evacuated across the province while helicopters and drones, 23 ships and 38,000 firefighters remain on standby, the Guangdong government said.

The central government has also sent evacuation and disaster aid, including more than 60,000 tents, beds, lights and family kits, state-run Xinhua news agency reported. AP

Israel strikes Gaza medical center amid growing genocide accusations

A Palestinian medical charity said on Tuesday that Israel destroyed its main center in Gaza City after ordering its evacuation. The Palestinian Medical Relief Society said an Israeli strike reduced its six-story building in the Tel al-Hawa neighborhood to rubble.

It said the center was one of the main facilities in the city providing blood donation and testing services, trauma care, cancer medicine and chronic disease treatment.

There was no immediate comment from the Israeli military, which has repeatedly bombed and raided hospitals in Gaza throughout the war.

Multiple hospitals in the famine-stricken city have been forced to shut down as Israel forces advance. Israel accuses Hamas of using medical facilities for military purposes — which could cause them to lose their protection under international law — but the military has often provided little or no evidence of a significant militant presence. The head of the World Health Organization, which has partnered with the charity, condemned the strike. "Attacks on health facilities must end. The senseless violence must stop. Cease-fire!" Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus wrote on X. A growing number of experts, including those commissioned by a U.N. body, have said Israel's offensive in the Gaza Strip amounts to genocide, deepening Israel's isolation and risking untold damage to the country's standing even among allies. The accusation is vehemently denied by Israel, which was established in part as a refuge for Jews after the Holocaust. Others have rejected it or said only a court can make that determination.

There have been calls for exclusion in the cultural and sports sectors, and protests in several European cities. AP

The Hindu American Foundation demanded action, labeling his remarks anti-Hindu hate. Social media users criticised his comments as disrespectful and contrary to American values.
